

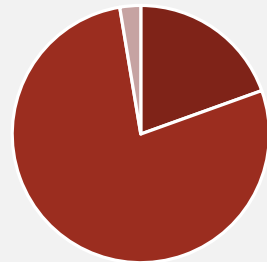

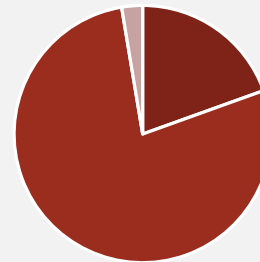

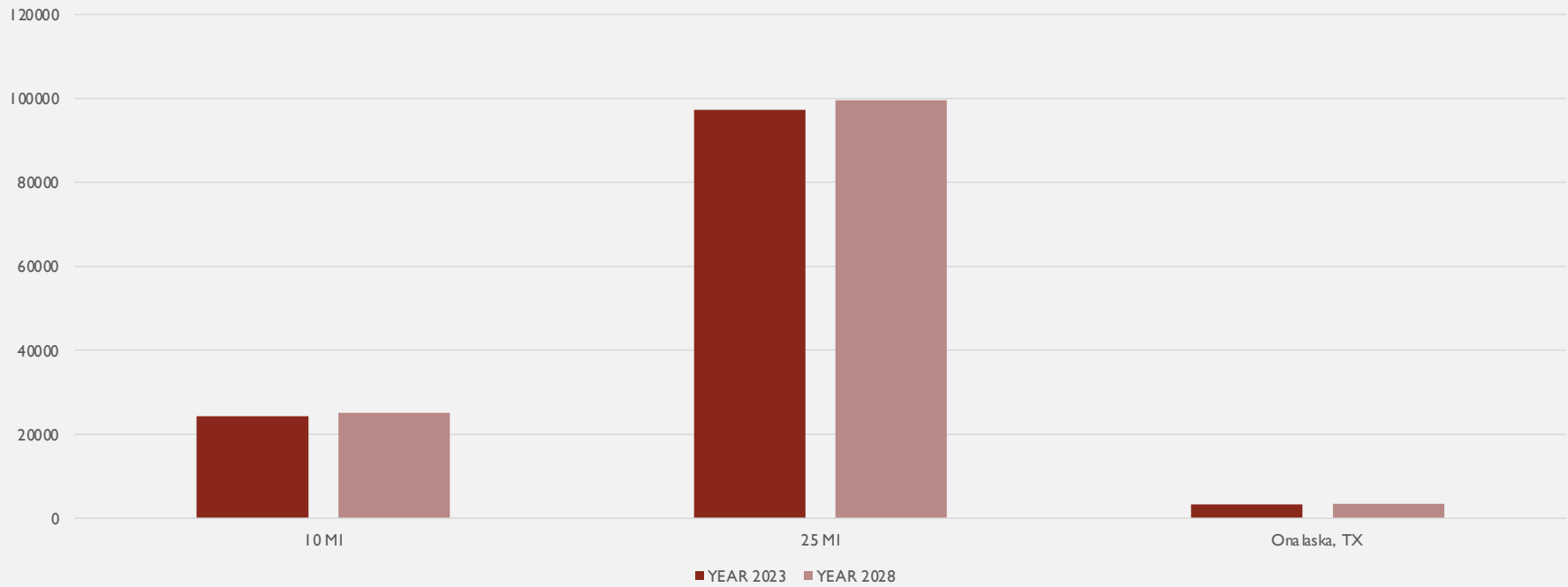

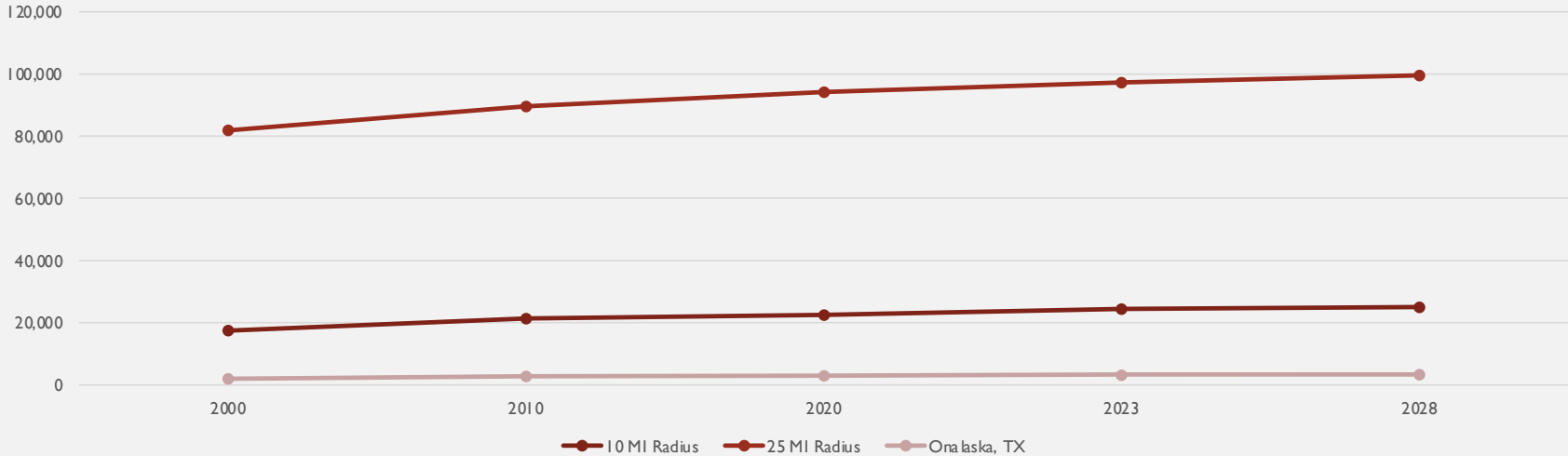

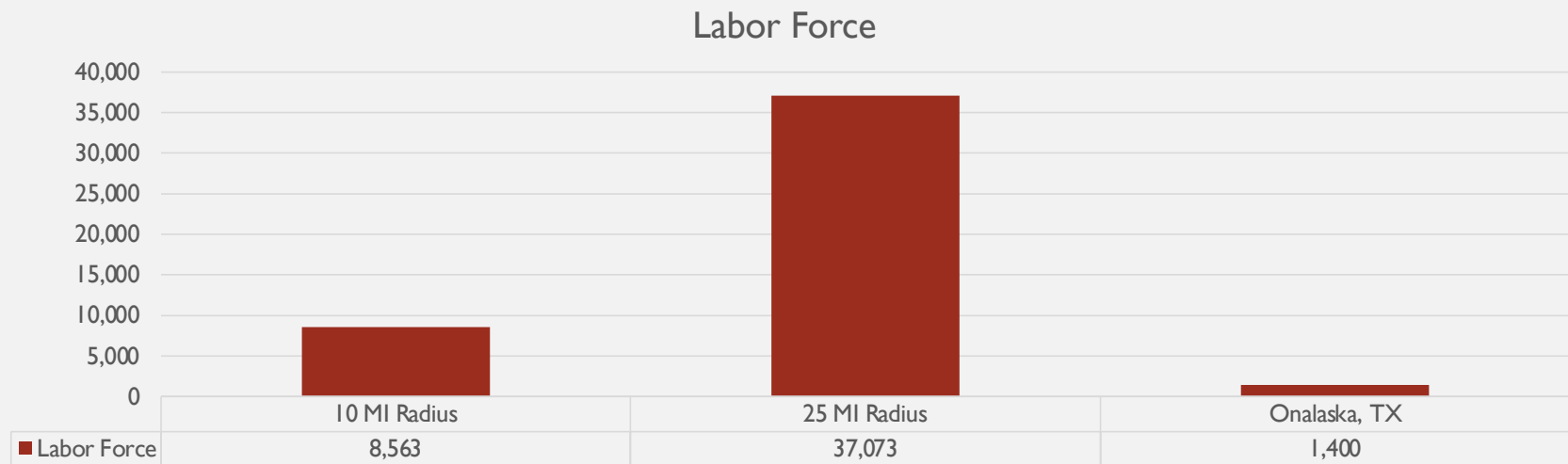
# TOTAL POPULATION



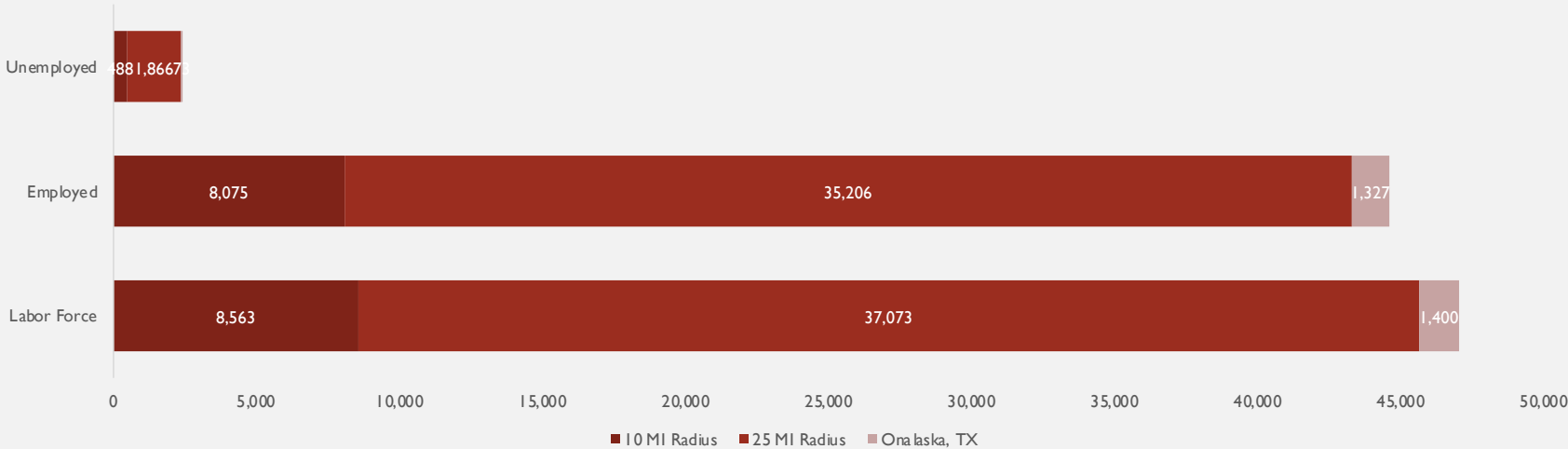
# POPULATION OVER TIME

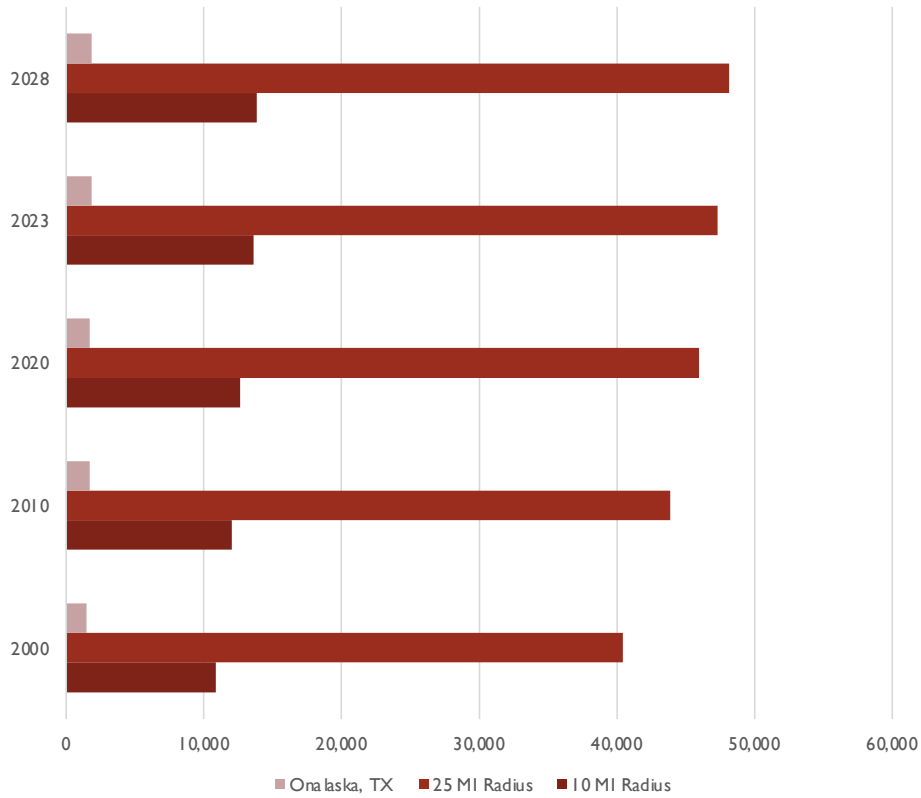

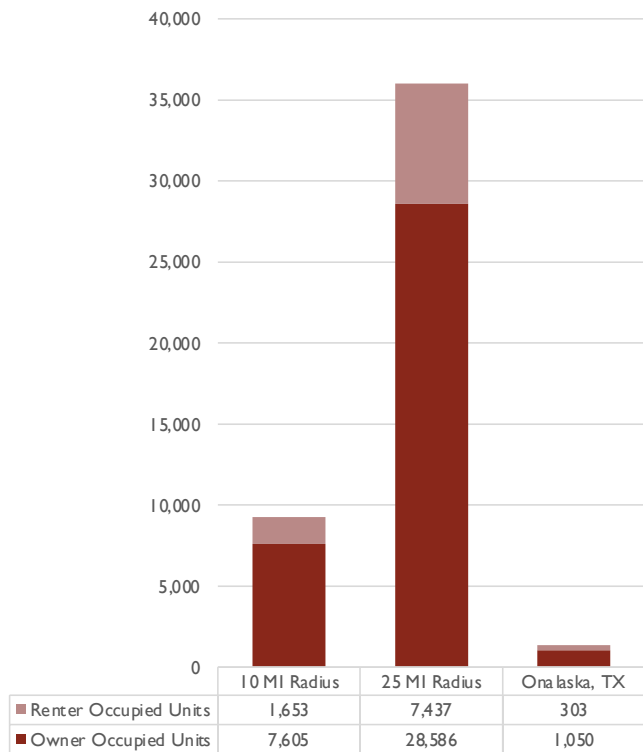


# EMPLOYMENT STATUS IN 2023

## HOUSING FACTS 2023

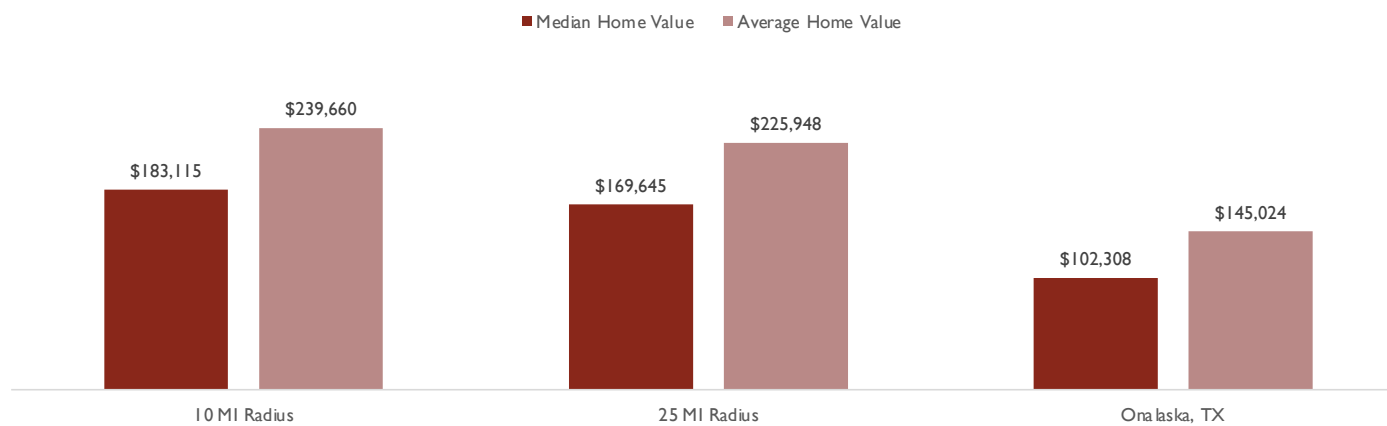
For Radius 10 mi: 82.13% Of households own their homes, 17.87% Of households rent

For Radius 25 mi: 79.35% Of households own their homes, 20.65% Of households rent

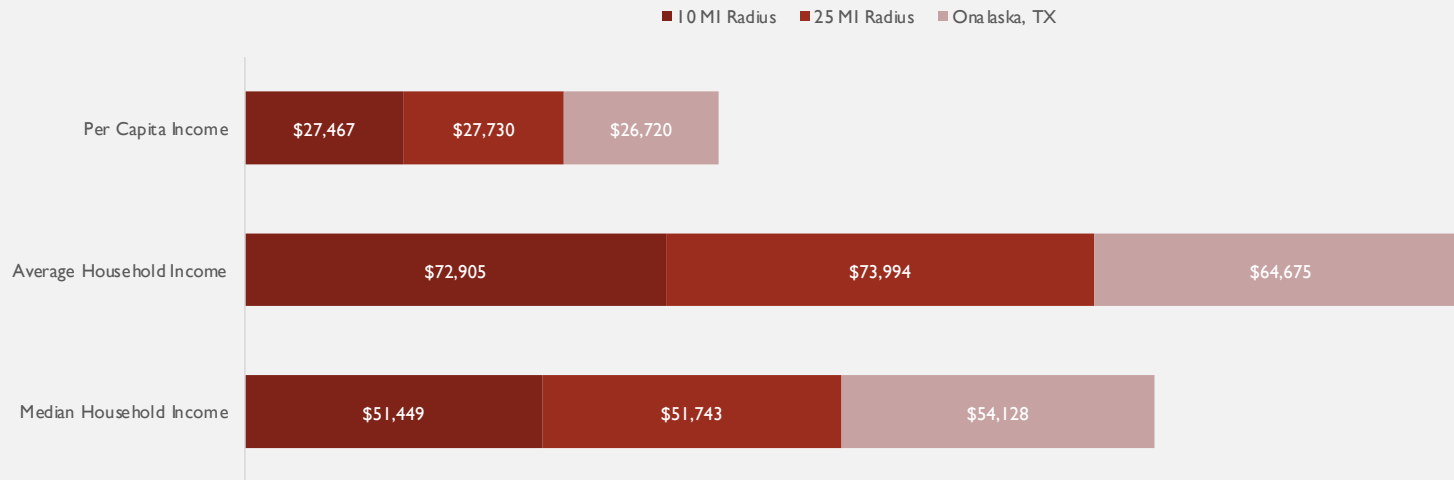
For Onalaska, TX: 77.57% Of households own their homes, 22.43% Of households rent



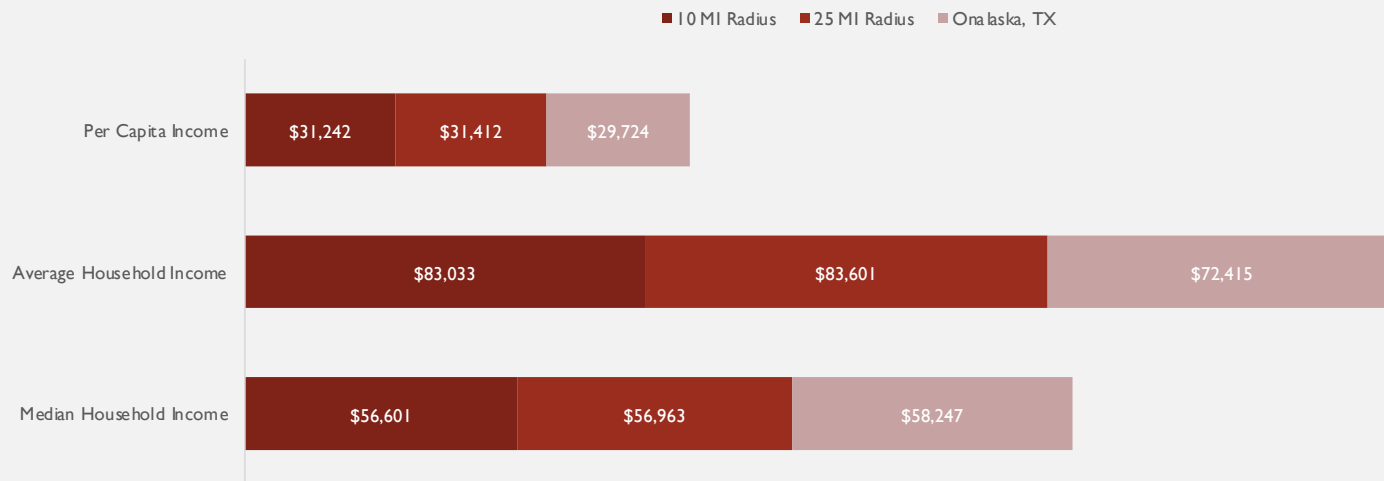
## MEDIAN AND AVERAGE HOME VALUES IN 2023

## KEY INSIGHTS

### 2023–2028

Population Dynamics - : From 2023 to 2028, Onalaska, TX projects a population growth rate of 3.2%, which is higher than the 25 MI radius (2.4%) with 10 MI radius at 3.6%

### 2028

Housing- Onalaska, TX showed an increase in housing units from 2000 (1,476 units) to 2028 (1,862 units). In 2023, out of the total housing units, 1,050 were owner-occupied, 303 were renter-occupied, and 481 were vacant.

Employment- In 2023, Onalaska, TX recorded an unemployment rate of 5.2%, while 10 MI recorded 5.7% and 25 MI recorded 5%.
